

MODIFICATIONS TO 2010 QUEEN'S HANDBOOK

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 2010

At the Executive Board Meeting, January 17, 2010, the following changes were proposed and approved for use during the 2010 Queen's contest:

In Section XI, subsection a, instead of the Association supplying the young ladies two (2) polo shirts, there will be three (3) provided with their name and logo.

At Convention, each member of the Executive Board and each club delegate will cast one vote for the candidate of their choice. This vote will be by secret ballot and held during the same portion of the Convention schedule as the election of Officers. These ballots will be collected by the Queen's Chairperson. Each vote will count as one point and any vote received by a candidate will be added to that candidate's total for the year.
