True Sportsmanship

I am sure by now we are all recovered from our four days in Bowie at Playday Finals 2008. I saw many things that I wish could have been better and I saw many things that made me proud to belong to such an organization and proud that I have been raised in the AASP&RC.

Most of us that have been in the association for any amount of time know that our motto is Horsemanship, Sportsmanship, and Citizenship. For some, the Horsemanship part is a lot easier than it is for others. Some can get on a horse and just look like a natural and never have an ounce of fear or an inch of movement in the saddle. Others of us, as the T-Shirt says, "are scared to death but have the courage to saddle up anyway"! I know that I fit in that group myself. Webster's defines citizenship as follows, "membership in a community: the quality of an individual's response to membership in a community." I think in the AASP&RC we all consider ourselves members of a single community and in some cases members of the same family, albeit a dysfunctional family, at times. When it all comes down to it we are still in this together.

However, sometimes in the heat of competition (and the heat outside for that matter), the hardest part of the motto to put into practice is Sportsmanship. I would like to share with you the best display of Sportsmanship I have ever seen in my years of riding and I am a past winner of an individual sportsmanship award at Playday Finals when those awards were still being given.

First of all, hats off to the Super Senior Women at Playday Finals 2008, Nancy Blackstock, Connie Ivins, Polly Moss, Varsi Klatzkin, Stephanie Cauthen, Lori Christian, Renee Guthrie, Alice Mitchell, Sylvia Quance, Sandy Bevil, Cheri Wallace, and Suzanne Wilson. I don't think there was a class that had more camaraderie than that one. I know I won't soon forget Connie Ivins standing outside the arena talking to my mom as Bouncer spun across the arena or Varsi Klatzkin teasing mom about her entourage to get Bouncer in the arena in the first place. They all yelled for each other and helped each other when they could. The two that I would like to spotlight as examples of Sportsmanship though are my own mother, Reserve High Point Super Senior Woman Suzanne Wilson and High Point Super Senior Woman Nancy Blackstock.

They could be heard yelling for each other every step of the way. As of Friday night my mom was eight points ahead for the saddle. At finals on Saturday mom and Bouncer, her horse, had a bobble in the Straight Barrels. Bouncer did not turn and this caused my mom not to place. As she came out of the arena Nancy was in tears because Bouncer did not turn. My mom told Nancy it was ok but now she wanted Nancy to go out and run a 9. Nancy told her she didn't think she could do that and return on top of her horse and they eventually settled on Nancy running a 10.1 and return atop her horse. Well Nancy went out there and ran a 9.7 in the straight aways and won 1st place. Nancy told my mom that if she had not heard her yelling for her that she might have hit the end barrel but she did and pushed her horse out and it went on past. After these girls ran the Spur in which my mom won 1st place and Miss Nancy won 2nd place by hundredths of a second it came out that Nancy had beat my mom by one point for the saddle. I went to tell my mom and the first thing that came out of her mouth was not "Oh man I didn't win", it was "I have to find Nancy and congratulate her". She found her, gave us her horse, and ran to tell Nancy they were one point apart. Nancy asked my mom, "well which way"? My mom told her that she was up by one. Then, at this point, all I hear is "you are kidding" and they were hugging and crying again. Nancy told my mom, "I have never had so much fun in all of my life as I have this week riding with you!" To me that is true Sportsmanship as the founders of the AASP&RC meant it to be.

More than one person told my mom they were sorry that she only missed the saddle by one point. She looked them straight in the face and said, "I am not. I had fun, I did my best and I made a good friend in Nancy Blackstock and that is why I playday. Think of all the people that are leaving here with nothing except the two brushes that they got on Wednesday morning. I am so privileged that I get to go home with a really pretty belt buckle". I myself will never win a saddle unless I get really brave one day and ride Bouncer (nobody count on that ok) but you know when my mom yells for me, even though I am 30 years old, you would think I was right in the thick of the points. She has always taught me to do the best I COULD and that was good enough to make her proud. Nancy Blackstock told my mom about something that she does with her own grandkids that teaches them to do their best and that it is ok if you are not always first place as well.

As I was standing at awards on that Saturday afternoon at finals I looked across the way and saw my mom and Nancy having their picture taken together with Nancy's highpoint saddle and mom's reserve buckle. I thought to myself that is true Sportsmanship right there and I hope that some of the younger people learn from that. I am proud that is my mom. So if we still gave those individual Sportsmanship awards like the one I received in 1987, at 9 years old in 2008, I would give it to these two ladies Nancy Blackstock and my mom Suzanne Wilson.

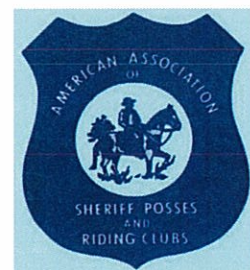
