
Our next District 2 meeting will be September 9th at 7:00 so we can start working on by-laws for this next year. We will be having elections of offices in November.


We are planning on having a benefit playday for a family that lost their grandmother to cancer. Her and her husband had been raising the grandkids. We are hoping to do that on October the 4th.
