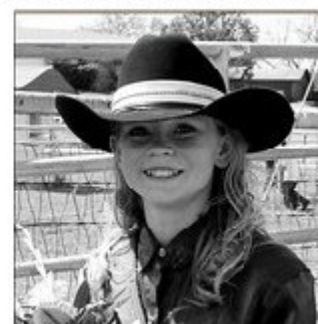

I hope everyone has had a great summer so far. Hopefully it will cool down soon.

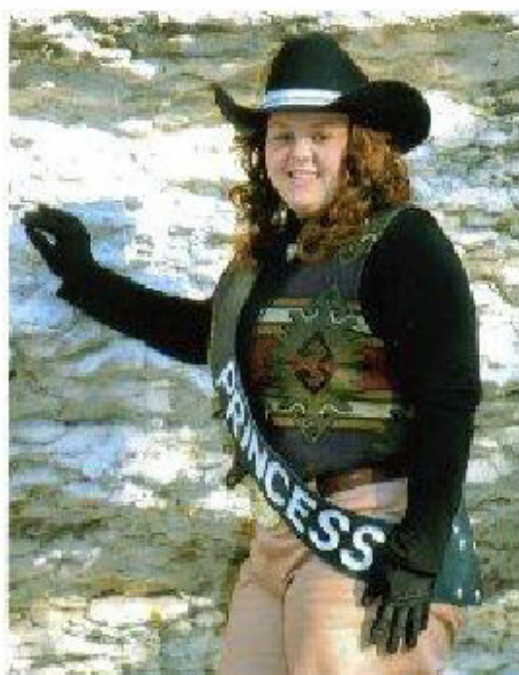

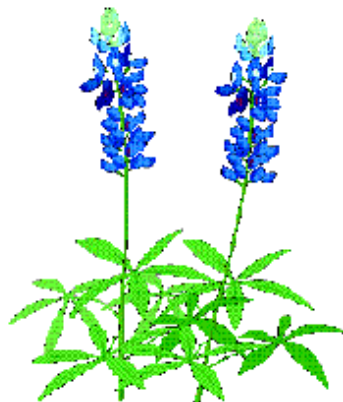

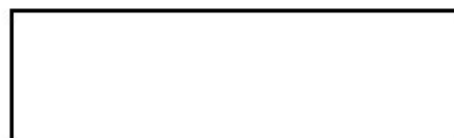
