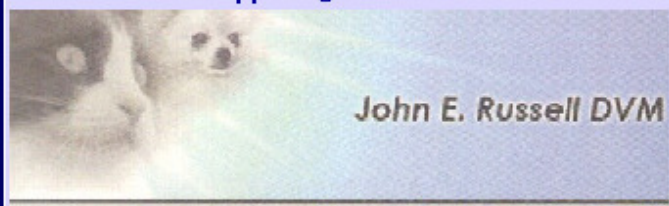
I would also like to express my sympathy to the Dean and Tassie Winters family on the loss of their horse Cisco to colic.

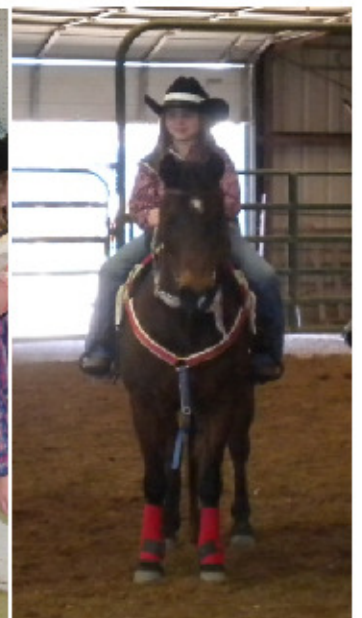

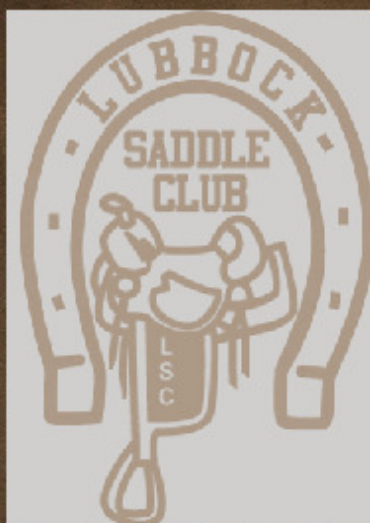
## *Emma Nisely*
